SGA Monthly Assembly

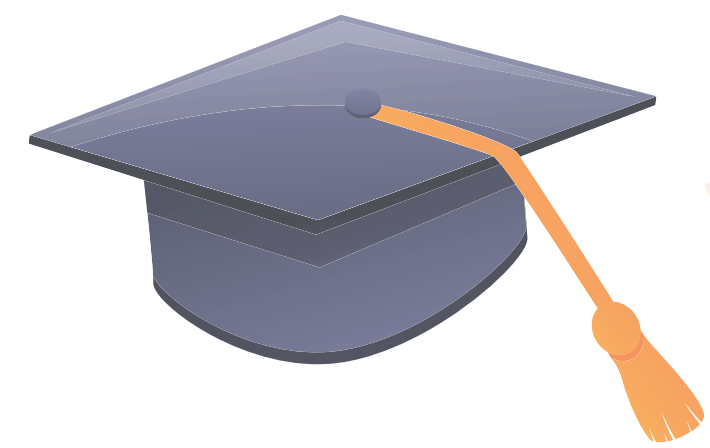
